TR AID



TR AID is a program that offers residents with disabilities access to a wide range of assistive technology through Regional TR AID Centers, along with device demonstrations. Below are some examples of equipment available to loan. Please note, this is a sample list, please contact us to request any adapted devices needed.

- **Mobility:** Wheelchairs, walkers, canes, crutches
- **Accessibility:** Ramps, grab bars, Hoyer lifts
- **Adaptive Furniture:** Seating, shower chairs, commodes
- **Safety:** Wander alarms
- **Tools:** Weighted items, adaptive utensils
- **Technology:** Laptops, iPads, communication aids
- **Assistive Devices:** Deaf/blind aids, learning tools
- **Pediatric:** Child-specific equipment
- **Recreational:** Adaptive toys and games
